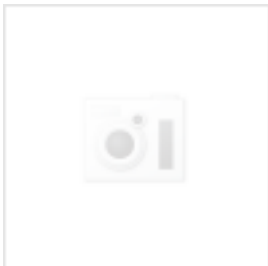
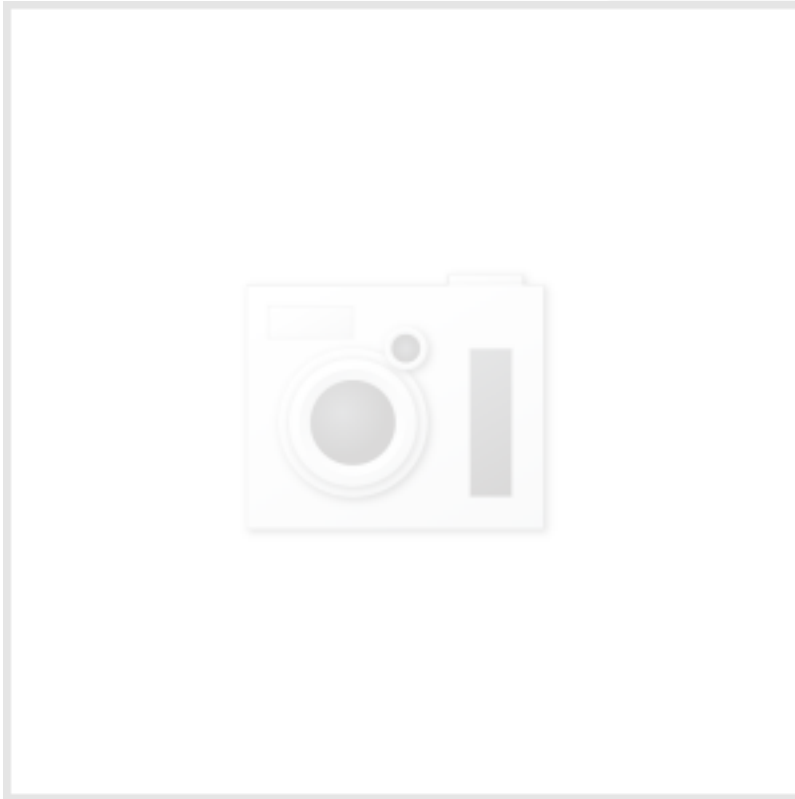

Arming garment worn under the armour, used by Roman legionnaires. Its main objective is amortisation of the blows. Subarmalis covers the torso and reaches down to the hips. It has no

sleeves. For surcharge we can add decorative leather finishing on arms and waist.

In standard outer layer and lining are made of cotton, but for surcharge it can be made of linen. Filling consists of two layers of batting. Quilted in rhombuses.

Available sizes:

S/M: chest girth 85-110 cm; waist girth 75-95 cm

L/XL: chest girth 110-130 cm; waist girth 95-125 cm
